- Ensure locker room is organized, neat, clean, and stocked throughout the day
- Launder and fold pool/locker room towels as needed throughout the day
- Maintain cleanliness and safety of sport courts, playground, bocce court, and all other recreational areas
- Assist with member recreational events & social activities, including our Independence Day & Labor Day parties
